

Milford D. Lester Memorial Cup Recreational Rowing Shell Race

Million Dollar Beach - Lake George Village, NY 12845

START at 12 Noon - Saturday, May 19th, 2007

Course: 11 miles from Million Dollar Beach, proceeding north, around Long Island, and returning to Million Dollar Beach. There are excellent parking and launching facilities at Million Dollar Beach. Registration will take place from 9:30 AM - 11:30 AM the morning of the race. A mandatory Skippers Meeting will be held at 11:30 AM. Launching and warm-up will begin at approximately 11:40 AM with the start promptly at 12 Noon.

This race is open to any Class I, II, III, or IV single recreational shells or Class I, II, and III double recreational shells. This is an IROW (International Recreational and Open Water Rowing Association) sanctioned event. All participants must be current IROW members. Membership applications are on the IROW web site, www.irow.org, or you may contact Blake Doyle (blakemunro@yahoo.com), membership secretary, for your membership status or further information. You may join IROW the day of the event, however, no one may race without an IROW membership - no exceptions.

Entry(s) received prior to May 11 (US Postmark determines date) are \$25/single or \$35/.double. Entry(s) received after May 11 (US Postmark determines date) are \$35/single or 45/double. Checks should be made payable to: "IROW". Entries will be accepted the day of the race at the higher entry fee.

LODGING:

DIRECTIONS:

FROM THE SOUTH & WEST: (These directions begin north of Albany, NY) Take I-87 North (The Adirondack Northway) to Exit 21. Stay straight on exit ramp to stop sign. Take a right at the end of exit ramp and proceed about 1/2 mile to traffic light at the intersection of Route 9. Take a left at the light onto Route 9 north. Proceed on Route 9 North for 1/10ths of a mile (straight through on set of traffic lights) to West Brook Road (not clearly marked but there is a green sign that says "Lake George Beach"). Take a right onto West Brook Road and proceed to the T intersection at the Beach Road. Take a right onto Beach Road. Proceed 2/10ths of a mile and take a left into the Million Dollar Beach parking lot.

FROM THE NORTH: Take I-87 South (The Adirondack Northway) to Exit 21. Stay straight on exit ramp to stop sign at end of ramp. Take a left at the end of exit ramp and proceed about 1/2 mile to traffic light at the intersection of Route 9. Take a left at the light onto Route 9 north. Proceed on Route 9 North for 8/10ths of a mile (straight through on set of traffic lights) to West Brook Road (not clearly marked but there is a green sign that says "Lake George Beach"). Take a right onto West Brook Road and proceed to the T intersection at the Beach Road. Take a right onto Beach Road. Proceed 2/10ths of a mile and take a left into the Million Dollar Beach parking lot.
